Block 707 Majura - Construction of a new solar farm

I refer to the works approval application, drawings and supporting information on the above works submitted to the National Capital Authority (NCA) for consideration on 03 September 2019. I also refer to further information submitted on 22 June, 7 July and 11 August 2020.

The NCA advises that:

Works Approval is granted pursuant to Section 12(1)(b) of the *Australian Capital Territory (Planning and Land Management) Act 1988* for the construction of a new solar farm located at Block 707 Majura as shown on Drawing Nos. 2 – 6, D303-0007-G, D303-0011-B, D303-0023-B, EPH-SOLS1-DD-ML-002, EPH-SOLS1-DD-MIL-005, EPH-SOLS1-PP-ML-006, 435-L1 - 435-L3, 01_SolarShare_2V-60-95_RS485, and as outlined in the supporting documentation submitted.

The term "works" is defined in the Act to exclude anything done inside buildings or structures. Under the Act works approval may be given where the works are in accordance with the National Capital Plan. This works approval is given only on the basis of satisfaction that the works are in accordance with the National Capital Plan and does not constitute building approval. It does not constitute any form of warranty as to the structural sufficiency of the proposed works, as to safety of the works or as to safety of the performance of the works. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure the safety of the works and the safety of the performance of the works and to ensure that any approvals required under separate legislation are also obtained.

Please Note:

1. Please ensure all works are consistent with the conditions listed in the approved *Statement of Heritage Effects* approved by the ACT Heritage Council, 9 June 2020.
2. Please ensure, where relevant, all necessary ACT Government approvals, including a temporary traffic management plan, are obtained prior to work commencing on site. A separate works approval may be required for temporary traffic management plans.
